4. For a school/group booking, our tariff is based upon a minimum number of 25 persons, unless otherwise agreed.

BURSARY FUND

Fellowship Afloat's Bursary Fund is set up to enable people with limited means to enjoy a course onboard *Trinity*. We invite those who wish to apply to contact the office; we will require basic information about need and how a visit will benefit the individual.

OUR RESIDENTIAL CENTRE

Trinity, our floating base has accommodation for 36 people in 2, 4 and 5 berth cabins. Moored on the East Coast it is the ideal activity venue for individuals, youth clubs, schools, churches, special needs and those wishing to gain RYA qualifications.

HOLIDAY INSURANCE

Fellowship Afloat is covered by public liability insurance which indemnifies the Trust in the event of accident or loss resulting from negligence on its part. Personal accident and property loss for visitors is not covered, so we advise you to make your own arrangements if insurance is required.

CONDITIONS OF BOOKING

- A booking is only secured when a deposit and booking form are received and acknowledged by us.
- If you cancel your booking, for whatever reason, the deposit is forfeited.
- The balance of fees must be paid four weeks before the start of a course.
- If you cancel your booking, for whatever reason, less than 12 weeks before the start of the course 60% of full fees are due; if less than two weeks, then full fees are due.
- If a booking has to be cancelled by the centre, and no acceptable alternative dates are available, all fees paid to the centre will be refunded.
- Should you have a change in circumstances, do contact the Fellowship Afloat office immediately; we will do all we can to accommodate your needs.
- Anyone participating in water activities must be fit for the activity and confident in water wearing a buoyancy aid (supplied at no extra cost by Fellowship Afloat).
